From the Director



I am delighted to launch the twelfth Belgrade Irish Festival (BIF) which will run for the duration of St. Patrick's Week.

The highlights of our programme include participation by several Irish cultural luminaries as well as our largest yet programme of films (15), all of which will be screened in Yugoslav Kinoteka, a wonderful cinema and cultural institution.

Jim Sheridan is our Special Guest and we thank him for honouring this annual celebration of Irish and Serbian cultures in the heart of the Balkans. Jim has been a major force in Ireland's cultural life - and his films have received nominations for sixteen Academy Awards, 14 Golden Globes, three Berlin International Film Awards, three WGAS, eight BAFTAs and eight IFTAs.

The Irish company Fishamble and actor Pat Kinevane will give 2 performances of KING at Bitef. KING is about a Corkman who prepares for a big night out as an Elvis impersonator - which unfolds into a mad tango between memory and longing. Pat Kinevane and Fishamble won a prestigious Olivier Award in London for Outstanding Achievement in

2016. We are lucky to have this performance in Belgrade as our timetables aligned with the play's outings at the Edinburgh Fringe and off-Broadway performances in New York, and Los Angeles.

Our film programme includes Iconoclasts, a section which explores the creativity of Irish actors including Peter O'Toole and Richard Harris. We will also have a repeat screening of Nothing Compares in honour of the late Sinéad O'Connor, and another on Shane MacGowan. A documentary will be screened on the life of gender-bending LGBT rights activist and icon, Panti Bliss, proves that gay rights can flourish even in the most unlikely of places, a once socially conservative country - Ireland.

We are delighted to present films directed by Alan Gilpin. Meditations on Ulysses and Dublin's artistic quarter come to life in The Ghosts of Baggotonia. And, to challenge your language skills, we will screen - with subtitles! An Buachaill Gealgháireach (The Laughing Boy), another film by Alan based on the circuitous route from Dublin to Athens of the Brendan Behan song. We also welcome Theo Dorgan to Belgrade this year, the renowned poet and narrator of The Laughing Boy.

A photography exhibition takes us through the lens of the Irish based photographer Joseph-Philippe Bévillard, capturing the lives and culture of a mostly nomadic ethnic group indigenous to Ireland, known as 'Travellers'.

On St. Patrick's Day, the TV presenter of Sasvim Prirodno program Jovan Memedović, and an Irishman with a long history in this eternal European capital, will discuss the reason why we have an annual Irish arts and cultural programme in Belgrade at all, and more illuminating facts about the Ireland and Serbia.

I am grateful to our Partners whose generous support of this green extravaganza each year. And our BIF Team and Volunteers whose dedication and work behind and front of scene(s) make this rare, and I hope enjoyable, north west – south east European connection possible. Thank you!

Jim Sheridan BIF Special Guest

Jim Sheridan is the Special Guest of the Belgrade Irish Festival. We thank him for honoring our 12th edition of the BIF annual celebration of Irish and Serbian cultures in the heart of the Balkans.

Jim is based in Dublin and is an Irish playwright, screenwriter, film director, and film producer. Between 1989 and 1993, he directed two critically acclaimed films set in Ireland, *My Left Foot* and *In the Name of the Father* - both of which will be screened in Kinoteka Belgrade, as part of Irish Film Week.

In addition, we are delighted to screen two documentaries which look into the lives of two great Irish actors, Peter O'Toole and Richard Harris. *Peter O'Toole: Along the Sky Road to Aqaba* (2022) was directed by Jim, who also comes out from behind the camera in *The Ghosts of Richard Harris*; discussing another of his successful films, *The Field*, with Harris in the lead role.

For most of us in Ireland, and around the world, we first experienced Jim's work through his remarkable break-through film, *My Left Foot*. In this film Daniel Day Lewis plays the role of true-life Dubliner Christy Brown, born with

Reditelj Džim Šeridan specijalni je gost ovogodišnjeg Beogradskog irskog festivala. Zahvaljujemo mu što će svojim učešćem uveličati 12. izdanje festivala, kojim svake godine proslavljamo irsku i srpsku kulturu u samom srcu Balkana.

Džim živi i radu u Dablinu, kao pisac, scenarista, filmski reditelj i producent. Između 1989. i 1993. godine, režirao je dva izuzetna filma čija se radnja odvija u Irskoj - "Moje levo stopalo" i "U ime oca". Oba filma biće prikazana u Kinoteci, u okviru filmskog programa BiF-a.

Pored toga, imamo veliko zadovoljstvo da prikažemo i dva dokumentarna filma koja istražuju živote dva velika irska glumca, Pitera O'Tula ("Duž nebeskog puta ka Akabi", u režiji Džima Šeridana) i Ričarda Harisa. U filmu "Duhovi Ričarda Harisa", Džim se pojavljuje ispred kamere i govorи o Harisovoj ulozi u zajedničkom filmu "Polje".

Za većinu nas u Irskoj, i ostatku sveta, prvi susret sa Džimovim radom bio je film "Moje levo stopalo" sa Danijel Dej Luisom u ulozi Kristija Brauna, koji je, uprkos cerebralnoj paralizi, koristeći samo levo stopalo, naučio da slika i piše.

cerebral palsy but who learns to paint and write with his only controllable limb - his left foot. With a searing pathos and, at times, raw humour, Christy's life opens us up to the remarkably rich life of a person born with disabilities, and netted the production (and Ireland) the international limelight with five Academy Award nominations; and two Oscars - for Daniel Day Lewis (Best Actor) and Brenda Fricker (Best Supporting Actor).

An important moment in Irish cinematic history, *My Left Foot* pre-empted the international success modern Ireland was to undergo at the dawn of the "Celtic Tiger". Like Ireland, Christy Brown was an unlikely and a marginalized hero, yet his determination and uniqueness of character helped define the broader era of hope and possibility that Ireland experienced in the 1990s. Jim Sheridan's films have been nominated for 16 Academy Awards, 14 Golden Globes, three Berlin International Film Awards, three WGAS, 8 BAFTA's and 8 IFTA's.

Jim has been a major force in Ireland's cultural

Filmovi Džima Šeridana imali su ukupno 16 nominacija za Oskara, 14 Zlatnih Globusa, 3 nagrade Međunarodnog festivala u Berlinu, tri nagrade Američkog saveza pisaca, 8 BAFTA i 8 IFTA nagrada.

Tokom četiri decenije duge karijere, Džim je bio pokretačka snaga irske kulture kako u oblasti filma, tako i u teatru. Uvek je bio glas generacije, hroničar irskog načina života kao i odnosa Irske sa spoljnjim svetom.

My Left Foot is the true story of Irish cerebral palsy victim Christy Brown. Paralyzed from birth, Brown (played by Hugh O'Conor as child and Daniel Day-Lewis as an adult) is written off as helpless. But Christy's indomitable mother (Brenda Fricker) never gives up on the boy.

Using his left foot, the only part of his body not afflicted, Brown learns to write and paint. He grows up to become a well-known author and painter. Day-Lewis and Fricker both won Academy Awards for their performances, and the film was nominated for Best Picture, Best Director, and Best Adapted Screenplay.

Screening is preceded by a presentation of director Jim Sheridan and Q&A after.

In the Name of the Father

This is a movie about a young man from Belfast, Gerry Conlon (Daniel Day-Lewis), who is forced to confess his involvement in a recent IRA attack that he didn't participate in.

He is aware that he's not a model citizen since he committed a robbery while staying in London. Before the real bomber admits the crime, Gerry is trying to keep his patience and sanity. This movie is a great story about injustice and a man who got in the middle of it, trying to find his way out. This movie was nominated in 7 categories for Academy Awards and is in the Imdb's TOP 250 movies of all time.

King tells the story of Luther, a man from Cork named in honour of his Granny Bee Baw's hero, Dr Martin Luther King Jr. Luther only leaves his apartment for essential journeys, and to perform as an Elvis impersonator.

The play explores prejudice, privilege, and resilience, as Luther struggles to live life to the full.

Mincéirs

Photography Exhibition by Joseph-Philippe Bévillard

Mincéirs are a traditionally nomadic ethnic minority indigenous to Ireland, referred to by the Irish Government and the settled population as Irish Travellers. The Mincéir is a true name of the Irish travelling community in their own language which is called Cant or Gammon. Although the Irish Travellers speak English, the lingo they use amongst each other at times is Cant/Gammon.

The name Traveller was given to them because of their nomadic identity. Back in the 5th century (CE) these groups of people were called Whitesmiths because of their association and skills such as tin-smithing. "We want every Traveller in Ireland to be proud of who they are and to say that we are not a failed set of people", said Brigid Quilligan, director of the Irish Traveller Movement in March 2017, following 25 years of campaigning leading to formal recognition as a distinct ethnic group within Ireland.

Minkeri

Minkeri su tradicionalna, autohtona, nomadska etnička manjina u Irskoj, koju irska vlada i narod najčešće nazivaju Putnicima. Naziv Minkeri (Mincéirs) je njihovo izvorno ime koje potiče iz njihovog jezika koji se zove kant ili gamon. Iako Minseri govore engleski, između sebe najčešće govore kant/gamon.

Ime Putnici su dobili zbog svog nomadskog načina života. Tokom petog veka ova grupa nosila je naziv Limari, jer su se uglavnom i bavili tim zanatom. "Želimo da se svaki Putnik u Irskoj oseća ponosnim i da veruje da nismo bez vrednosti" rekla je Bridžid Kiligan, ispred Pokreta irskih Putnika, 2017. godine, povodom 25 godina borbe koja je rezultirala formalnim priznanjem Putnika kao posebne etničke grupe u Irskoj.

"We have our own unique identity, and we shouldn't take on all the negative aspects of what people think about us. We should be able to be proud and for that to happen our State needed to acknowledge our identity and our ethnicity, and they're doing that today."

Since moving to Ireland in 1990, Joseph-Philippe has focused his photography on the lives and culture of the mostly nomadic people in Ireland known as 'Travellers'. He started drawing and painting after he lost his hearing at the age of 3. He took up photography during his senior year at a private school in Massachusetts and continued his education in photography at Rochester Institute of Technology and the Art Institute of Boston.

Joseph-Philippe's dedication to the subject has seen him earn the trust and access from the Travelling community needed to take such intimate portraits. This exhibition is just a portion of the vast body of his work, which has been published and exhibited widely, including in the Skeleton Key Press, Amnesty International, L'Oeil de la Photographie, LeTemps, Der Spiegel, Vogue Italia, Square, Shots, Lenswork and Life Force as well as received awards from All About Photo, International Photography Awards, PX3, Photo Vogue Italia, FotoNostrum, The Independent Photographer and LensCulture and elsewhere over the past.

Photography Exhibition by Ed Godsell

Ed Godsell is from County Cork and graduated from the National Film School of Ireland (I.A.D.T) in early 2000's. Since then he has worked as a freelance documentary cameraman and director.

Following his first trip to the Balkans (Kosovo) in 2013, he found the region so rich in stories and culture he decided to move here and has been photographing it ever since. He has lived throughout the region including Macedonia, Bosnia and Serbia.

Ed has worked in many parts of the world ranging from Ukraine to Africa to Gaza and the West Bank. This exhibition is the first ever of his photography, which was mainly created when he was working in above mentioned areas. It is a small selection of his overall body of work which ranges from social to political to street photography and portraiture.

Irish Literature in Belgrade

Theo Dorgan

This year's BIF program sees the arrival of one of Ireland's most well-known poet's, Corkonian Theo Dorgan.

Discussion led by Mark Keating & Jovan Memedović

In a short time I blended in with these people to find a lifelong love for this 'unloved' part of Europe. I was soon to realize why I felt so comfortable here.

Jovan and I will discuss our common connections that will help us to understand why two peoples who live so far apart geographically, are so similar in so many ways."

Importantly Shane never really co-operated with any film again. It captures him before his health began to deteriorate.

This screening is dedicated to Shane and for his many followers in Serbia.

Maradona. Pelé. Best. Northern Ireland's legendary star remains one of the most naturally gifted footballers there has ever been. Famously called the 'best player in the world' by Pelé, George Best galvanized Manchester United's five-year recovery from the tragedy of the Munich air crash.

He was football's first rock and roll star – a handsome, charismatic Belfast boy who could thrill and excite the crowds with every turn of the ball. Yet George Best was also the lead in his own Shakespearean tragedy; a flawed genius, brought down by drink, temptation and depression.

Ghosts of Baggotonia Duhovi Bagotonije

Director: Alan Gilsenan

2022 • 80 min • Feature Documentary, Literature & Arts

An evocative film-poem exploring the literary and other ghosts of the bohemian quarter bordering Dublin's Baggot Street during the mid-20th century. "Baggotonia" – as it has become known – was both a permeable geographic area and a cultural movement, populated by writers, artists and other intellectuals living an anarchic life at odds with the over-arching drabness and the conservative mores of the time.

Inspired by a rare collection of photographs from artist Nevill Johnson, the film is shot in starkly beautiful monotone and draws on the writings of the period. It is also an act of psycho-geography as well as a personal meditation on the childhood of film-maker Alan Gilsenan – who grew up amidst the ghosts – on the mythical Raglan Road.

Screening is preceded by a presentation of publici pre projekcije filma i odgovarati na pitanja nakon projekcije.

Ovaj evokativan i poetski film istražuje književne duhove boemske četvrti ulice Bagot u Dablinu tokom sredine dvadesetog veka. Bagotonija – naziv pod kojim je ovaj deo grada postao poznat, istovremeno je bio kulturni pokret ali i geografska odrednica, kvart u kome su pisci, umetnici i intelektualci vodili život u suprotnosti sa preovladavajućim sivilom i konzervativizmom tog doba.

Inspirisan kolekcijom retkih fotografija umetnika Nevila Džonsona, film je snimljen u začuđujućoj lepoti crno - bele tehnike, a temelji se na ključnim književnim autorima tog perioda. Film je takođe delo psihogeografije, i intimna meditacija na detinjstvo autora Alana Gilsenana – koji je i sam odrastao među duhovima mitskog Raglan Rouda.

"The Laughing Boy" was written by a teenage rebel Brendan Behan in memory of another iconic rebel, Michael Collins. Translated by the poet Vasilis Rotas, Behan's words in Greek were set to music by the legendary Mikis Theodorakis.

The film takes poet Theo Dorgan on an odyssey of his own uncovering histories bound together by something more profound and transcendent: the power of a song.

The screening is preceded by a presentation of writer and narrator Theo Dorgan and Q&A.

Irska pesma koja je imala drugi život kao "To Yelasto Paidi", himna otpora diktatorskom režimu u Grčkoj tokom 60. i 70. godina, i do danas je ostala moćna kulturna sila. "Dečak koji se smeje" napisao je mladi Brendan Bihani, u znak sećanja na buntovnika Majkla Kolinsa. U prevodu grčkog pesnika Vasilisa Rotasa, muziku na ove Bihaneve stihove komponovao je legendarni Mikis Teodorakis. Film prati irskog pesnika Tea Dorgana na ličnom putovanju, dok pokušava da pronikne u to kako su istorije ove dve zemlje povezane nečim mnogo dubljim i užvišenijim, a to je moć pesme.

Experimental in approach and semi-abstract in style, this film/installation is an immersive cinematic experience, richly visual and stimulating personal interpretation of the book. The film is a Yellow Asylum Films Production for the Museum of Literature in Ireland.

Irish writer, filmmaker and theater director Alan Gilsenan has received three Irish Film and Television Awards (IFTAs) and six IFTA nominations as both director and production designer.

Baltimore is a psychological thriller based around an actual armed raid in 1974, in which 19 masterpieces were stolen from one of Ireland's great houses – Russborough in Co. Wicklow. The raid was masterminded by English Heiress Rose Dugdale in her efforts to support the IRA armed struggle at that time. The film charts her journey from privileged aristocrat to committed rebel.
